The Workshop "Advances in Cardiovascular Diseases and Therapy", promoted by the International School of Cardiology, will cover several topics starting with the presentation of the last Guidelines of the European Society of Cardiology concerning the management of Cardiovascular Disease in patients with Diabetes, the management of Cardiomyopathies, of Endocarditis and of acute Coronary Syndromes, the focused update of the 2021 ESC Guidelines for the Diagnosis and Treatment of acute and chronic Heart Failure, the 2023 ESH Guidelines on Arterial Hypertension, and an updating on the Cardio-Oncology, a new and emerging branch of Cardiology (with a whole session dedicated) and on treatment of Pulmonary Hypertension, and VT/PE diagnosis and treatment. Moreover, the Clinical Consenso Statement of the EAPCI of the ESC on the Evaluation and management of patients with Coronary chronic total occlusione considera for revascularization, and the ACC/AHA and ESC/EACTS Guidelines for the Management of Valve Heart Diseases in comparison with the JACC Guidelines, will be discussed.

Estensive discussion will be devoted to correction of risk factors, cardiac rehabilitation, correct life style, reduction of smoking risk and new emerging pathologies such as obesity and its new treatments. Moreover, attention will be dedicated to an important cardiac pathology as Atrial fibrillation and means to detect its silent form.

Moreover, interventional cardiology not only for the treatment of coronary stenosis but also for structural and valve cardiopathies (PFO, left auricle, TAVI, Mitraclip) will be extensively treated including the rationale use of anti-thrombotic therapy as well as the interventional arrhythmology with a discussion of the indications for the ICD application for the prevention of sudden death to prolong the survival of patients in secondary but also in primary prevention, when appropriate, including new extravascular device.

However, in the last years, noninvasive imaging has made great progress becoming crucial indiagnosing several heart diseases.

New echocardiographic techniques, such as 3D echo, global longitudinal strain, myocardial deformation imaging, cardiac magnetic resonance (CMR) and computed coronary angiography have been perfected to diagnose and follow up many cardiac diseases.

Progress has been reached in diagnosing and treating rare cardiomyopathies such as Amyloidosis. For this reason, it is essential that not only cardiologists, involved in the field of imaging, but also general cardiologists and other specialists taking care of patients with heart disease, become confident with these techniques to prescribe them appropriately and understand the added value of the information they can

give.

From the therapeutic point of view, relevant progress has been reached in the prevention and treatment of cardiovascular diseases with the introduction in the routine medical therapy of new drugs as suggested by recent ESC Guidelines.

Finally, an emerging field of interest is the Artificial Intelligence with application in cardiovascular prevention, in heart failure management and in cardiac imaging interpretation.

## Goals

The Workshop is designed for fellows of the post-graduate Schools of the Sicilian Universities as well as specialists in Cardiology, Internal Medicine, Geriatrics, Cardiac Surgeons, and General Practitioners.

The Workshop aims to give modern information on the most actual topics.

During the Course, frontal lectures delivered by recognized scientists will alternate with interactive discussion. Earlier diagnosis of cardiac disease may favor better preventive strategies and tailored therapeutic intervention with obvious beneficial effects
